You've heard the importance of paint to a space. It can instantly create a clean and modern vibe with minimal effort. Then why is chooing the right color such a challenge?

It all comes down to the undertones. The reason why some of the most perfect white shades can look creamy. And why the grey paint on your friends wall make look purple in your space.

After flipping houses for 15 years and sampling hundreds of paint colors, I've landed on a few that deliver time and time again.

SO use this guide to start with your own selections. Trust me, it's must easier to work with a narrowed down list than to search Pinterest or Instagram.

Next to each color there is a key to show where I've used the colors (I=interior, E=exterior, $\mathrm{A}=$ accent). Follow the steps I use to make sure the colors work for each individual space and take comfort in knowing you've just saved yourself time and energy searching. So get ready to confidently paint away.

## HOW I TEST PAINT COLORS BEFORE CHOOSING

When working with new paint colors I always test first. Here's my steps to making the right choice the first time.


## MAKE A LIST OF POTENTIAL COLORS

To make mixing samples easy I like to make a list before I leave home. I include the manufacturer, name and number when available.

## GET SAMPLES FROM THE STORE

Bring you list to the store and have samples of your colors mixed to try out. Don't forget the sample pack of disposable brushes.

## PAINT SWATCHES

Take each sample and paint a $12 \times 12$ section to easily compare colors. Make sure to check color at different times of the day (sun/shade/night) for best results.

## CHOOSE PAINT AND FINISH

Once you've got the color chosen make sure to also specify the type of finish you want. Flat, semi-gloss or satin are options depending upon the room and wear.

## PREP FOR FUTURE TOUCH UPS

Store excess paint and label it according to each room where it was used. This makes for easy touch ups in the future. Also considering keeping a note or spreadsheet for future reference. Include ceiling and trim paint too.
